Academic Eligibility Policy for ECA Participation

At DSC International School, we believe that excellence on the field, court, or stage begins with accountability in the classroom. While extracurricular programs are designed to develop well-rounded students, academic responsibilities always come first.

To support our students' long-term success, we enforce a strict "Complete to Compete" academic eligibility policy for ECA participation.

As such, to participate in any athletic game, practice, club event, or extracurricular performance, students must not have any outstanding assignments. Students with failing grades must also be making a concerted effort to improve.

Unlike traditional "no pass, no play" rules that focus strictly on grades, "Complete to Compete" focuses on effort and accountability. A student's eligibility is determined by their completion of assigned work, including remedial assignments as determined by the teacher.

To be eligible to be involved in varsity teams and clubs, a student must have all assignments submitted; otherwise, the student will be temporarily sidelined from competition. Students with missing work will also not be able to attend practices until they have completed all outstanding work.

For Students: You are a student-athlete or student-performer—student always comes first. Manage your time and communicate with your teachers *before* an assignment becomes overdue.

For Parents: We ask for your partnership in monitoring Edsembli Parent Portal weekly. Encourage your child to advocate for themselves and get the assignments done on time so they can enjoy their passions outside of it.

We want every student out there representing our school. If you want to suit up and play, you have to hand it in and complete it. Complete to compete—no exceptions.
